Range and Safety Rules

Range Hours:

Monday - Saturday 8am to Dusk, Sunday: 12 noon to Dusk, Wednesday ALL ranges closed at 5pm

General Range Rules; See Specific Range for additional rules pertaining to that Range

- Obey the speed limit while on the club grounds.
- No one but the member may use their member card to access the club.
- Members must prominently display the current year membership card on their person at all times.
- Only members and no more than 2 guests accompanied by the member may use the ranges.
- Members and guests are required to stop and sign in at the shed prior to shooting.
- Members who wish to bring a non-member (guest) to shoot must complete a "Temporary Membership" form located in the shed and remit the appropriate fee. The "Temporary Membership" card must be worn by the non-member at all times, and must also remain with the member. The \$5.00 fee does not apply to immediate family members/spouse under the age of 18, they still need to fill out the guest paperwork and sign in.
- Special rules posted at each range must be observed.
- All shooters and spectators must wear suitable eye and ear protection.
- No alcoholic beverages permitted on the ranges.
- Shooting while under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicating substances is prohibited.
- When anyone is down range no weapons shall be handled. Actions shall be open and magazines removed.
- The first Shooter on a range is Designated Safety Officer and has full control of Range.
- Shooting **MUST** be done from the firing line only.
- Always make sure your weapon is pointed in a safe direction so any discharges will not leave club property.
- No Targets can be placed directly on the ground. (Bowling Pins, Clay Birds, Ground Bouncers).
- Except where noted only paper or cardboard targets may be used.
- All targets have to be placed on the backers between the uprights.
- No targets may be placed or leaning on any metal (frames, legs, etc.) (i.e. plastic or glass bottles, clay birds, pins, etc.).
- No fully automatic, simulated fully automatic or hip shooting is allowed.
- Shooting shotguns or multi projectile ammo at backers is prohibited.
- Shooting at glass objects or electronics is prohibited on all ranges. (TVs, Hard Drives, Computers etc.)
- Shooting at cans and plastic bottles is permitted only on designated ranges and waste must be placed in trash.
- Range 1: Handgun calibers only! No handguns with braces.
- Range 2: Handgun calibers only! No handguns with braces. Rimfire .22 rifles only.
- Range 3: Handgun calibers only! No handguns with braces. Magnum pistol cartridges are not permitted.
- Ranges 4 & 5: No more than 1 shot every 3 seconds.
- Ranges 4 & 5: No more than 5 rounds in a magazine and chamber combined.
- Ranges 4 & 5: **ONLY PAPER TARGETS ALLOWED**
- No Trap or Skeet Shooting (no aerial targets).
- No steel core, penetrators, tracers, incendiary, dragons breath or similar ammunition.
- No 50 BMG on any range.
- No Exploding Targets on ANY range.
- Remove all targets when you are done shooting.
- Police your brass including miss fires.
- Bows and arrows are not permitted on firearms ranges.
- Indoor range is for organized shooting events only. No magnum ammunition. Rifles .22 Rimfire caliber only.
- Hunting on Club Property is Prohibited.
- All shooting must stop at dusk (when parking lot lights turn on).

Unami Fish & Game Protective Association New Member Orientation

This orientation will inform new members about club rules, responsibilities and safety practices.

Access to club property

Only members and their guests may use the club and its facilities. Exceptions may be given for authorized activities.

2. Junior (under 18)
3. Lifetime (new applications temporarily suspended)

Range Hours

Monday – Saturday 8 am – Dusk, Sunday 12 pm – Dusk; Wednesdays: all ranges close at 5 pm for grounds work

Guest Information

- All guests must be signed in at the shed near the entrance to the shooting ranges prior to shooting.
- Only members and their accompanied guests may use the ranges. Guests may not use a member's card.
- Spouses and children/grandchildren under the age of 18 are welcome free of charge. However, they must complete a "Temporary Membership Form/Waiver"
- All other guests must complete a "Temporary Membership Form/Waiver" and remit \$5 per guest per day. Forms can be found in the sign in shed. Guests must wear the Temporary Membership card at all times and must remain with the member.
- All members must have their current membership card on them and visible at all times.

1	Handgun Pin Range	7 yard 48 x 48 inch target stands 11 yard 48 x 48 inch target stands 11 yard bowling pin tables	Handgun calibers only! No rifles, AR's or shotguns. No handguns with braces.
2	Plinking Range	25 yards Two 48 x 48 inch target stands Two 42 x 30 inch target stands	Handgun calibers only! .22 caliber rifles allowed. No handguns with braces.
3	25/50 Handgun Range	25-50 yards combination range 25-50 steel targets	Handgun calibers only! No handguns with braces. Magnum pistol cartridges are not permitted. Only sectioned steel targets permitted Paper targets on backers.
4	Rifle Range	50 yards Five 48 x 48 inch target stands One shotgun pattern area and stand	No more than 1 shot every 3 seconds. Paper targets only. No steel targets permitted
5	Rifle Range	100 yards Five 48 x 48 target stands	Only club provided moveable target No more than 5 rounds in chamber and magazine combined
Archery Range			
1	Practice area	10, 15, 20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 45, 50 and 60 yard practice butts	No broad heads on club targets
2	Walk-through Archery Course	15 butts	
Indoor Range (all firearms must have iron sights, Red Dot or Scope installed)			
1	Handgun & Rimfire Rifle	25 yards 14 shooting points with turning targets	Organized shooting events only Handgun calibers only! No magnum ammunition. Rifles limited to rimfire caliber.
